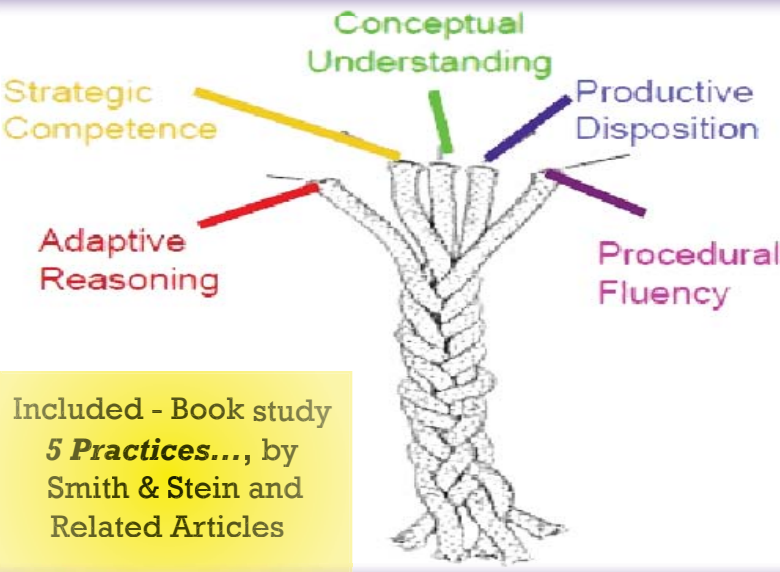

- Teachers will continue to focus on three things:
1. The 8 Mathematical Practices – “What do they look like?” “What do they sound like?”
 2. Engaging Mathematical Lessons – “How to develop them?” “What impact does that have on teaching and learning?”
 3. Developing an Annual Plan for Implementation.

Participants will also have classroom coaching opportunities, which include observations, planning, and reflection sessions.
